found and with help from Slagle descendents, Ron Holley, EmmaLee Price, and Julie Dresser we were able to purchase a fence to install around the site.

On Mothers Day, May 13, 2001, wife Judy, sons Tad & Tony, and I , with help from Robin and Sussie got the fence installed around the site.

On October 07, 2001, I, my wife Judy, sons Tad & Tony and grandson James Hammans returned and reset some of the stones. As no one could come up with how the stones were installed in the original cemetery the stones were reset as a memorial area.

One June 15, 2003 wife Judy, son Tony and I returned and reset the rest of the 12 stones. The broken stone of Peter W. Slagle was left where it was found standing and the stones of Peter Slagle died June 08, 1862 aged 83 yr. 6 months, 16 days and his wife's stone, Barthena Slagle died Aug. 16, 1865 aged 70 yr. 9 months, 22 days were set in the front row.



This is the middle section of the stone of Peter W. Slagle Died Feb 24, 1862, aged 53 Year 4 months 1 day the son of Peter and his first wife. Top piece can not be found. Bottom is upright in cement it was set in.



The stone of Peter Slagle Died June 08, 1863 aged 83 yr 6 months 16 days.
This stone was found broken and was set in a pressure treated wood frame
